

## ITSAK Report on the Recent Athens, Greece Earthquake

A preliminary report on the Athens, Greece earthquake of September 7, 1999, has been posted on our web site. The report was prepared by the Institute of Engineering Seismology and Earthquake Engineering (ITSAK). The destructive earthquake that hit the capital of Greece (fortunately without damage to ancient monuments) was of moderate magnitude ( $M = 5.9$ ) and caused serious damage in the northern suburbs of Athens. According to ITSAK, the causative fault was “unknown” and for the time being, no fault trace has been observed on the surface.
